The outputs of an AMEM assessment allow an organisation to compare itself with industry peers and against world best practices. We also audit and certify to BSI PAS 55, the Publicly Available Specification for Asset Management published by the British Standards Institute.

Developing People

Asset Management as a discipline is relatively new. AMCL provides a range of training and development programmes aimed at individuals and corporations to fast-track the development of their competence. We have submitted our courses for endorsement by the Institute of Asset Management (IAM).

Courses comprise:

- 1. Executive Briefing** - an executive level briefing on the benefits Asset Management can deliver, and the role of the top team in implementing it
- 2. Asset Management Primer** - this course is an introduction to Asset Management theory and best practice and is normally one day in duration. This is aimed at senior and middle management and is also a pre-cursor to the more detailed Principles course.
- 3. Asset Management Principles** - a three day walk through the application of Asset Management theory and best practice. It comprises six modules of half a day each, and is aimed at developing a more detailed appreciation of Asset Management best practice. These six modules cover the educational aspects of the IAM's Competences Framework.
- 4. Asset Management Practitioner** - a range of detailed courses focused on specific aspects of Asset Management which will give attendees a clear understanding of the selected area of study.
